Program Description	Both SHSM and non-SHSM students have an opportunity to explore a career through a full day Co-op placement in a sector/business of their choice (based on local placement availability).  SHSM students may count these credits towards their SHSM diploma requirements; this full day learning experience will provide time to apply knowledge and develop work-related skills; students will have the opportunity to develop essential skills and work habits; students will make sector/industry specific connections; students will improve self confidence and gain valuable workplace experience.
